



A step by step guide to the design of bespoke wallpaper/wall mural

CONSULTATION –

Miss Swanne meets with you and views the potential wall space. Together we discuss ideas (any photos, images, fabrics or magazine tear sheets you have all help!) and what you or your child is looking for from the design. At this point it would be great to take some photos of the space.

Alternatively I am happy to discuss this over the phone (07788 641306) .If you could then send through pictures of the space to me via email (caz@missswanne.com) and the wall dimensions too.

AGREE TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS – the small print! I will send you a quote based on the design and space, and at this point there are the Terms & Conditions to sign so the job may commence.

DEPOSIT – Once the deposit has been paid in full it's all systems go on the design front.

DESIGN – I design in pencil first and then translate this to the computer, when I'm happy with how it is looking I will email you with the rough proposal for the room. (I will let you know how long this design stage will take dependant on how busy things are.)

ADAPTS – After seeing the design if you have any small amends to make, this is the time to tell me!

CONFIRMATION OF DESIGN – Once the design has been finalised – its all systems go...

SERVICE

*Wallpaper can be delivered direct to your door ready to be hung – instructions of how best to do this can be emailed across. Alternatively dependant on location I can recommend some suppliers.

*Painting can take between 1-5 days, it's all down to the size and detail of the design.

After the wallpaper has arrived safely or the last of the paint has dried on the walls please be sure to complete the final payment.
